What is a Scholarship fund? Each year monetary donations are made to the convention to help subsidize the registration fee for the women in the KEY, a treatment facility in Lorain County, the women residents in recovery living at the Lorain County YWCA and The Hannah House, another women's recovery house. Without the generous donations of the past and donations for this convention, these women would not have the opportunity to attend this convention and learn first hand that life really begins after alcohol.

**From the West** (These directions are based coming from the Sandusky area. If you know where Cedar Point is, these directions are the ones to follow. This is approximately a 30 mile drive.)

1. Take **OH-2 / I-90 EAST**
2. Continue on **OH-2 EAST** - go **21.7** mi
3. Turn **R** onto Ramp towards **OH-58 / Amherst / Oberlin / Lorain (N LEAVITT RD)** exit - go **0.3** mi
4. Turn **L** on **OH-58/N LEAVITT RD** - go **0.3** mi
5. Turn **R** on **COOPER FOSTER PARK RD/COOPER FOSTER PARK RD E** - go **1.2** mi
6. Continue on **COOPER FOSTER PARK RD** - go **< 0.1** mi
7. Turn **L** on **OBERLIN AVE** - go **0.8** mi
8. Proceed approximately 1 mile. **Rosewood Place** is on the right. Arrive at **4493 OBERLIN AVE, LORAIN**

**From the East** (If you pick up I-480 by the Airport, it is approximately 23 miles to the destination.)

The goal is to get onto the Ohio Turnpike and go West.)

1. Take **I-480 WEST** towards **TOLEDO** - go **7.8** mi
2. Take the **OHIO TURNPIKE/TOLL ROAD/I-80 WEST** exit towards **TOLEDO** - go **6.8** mi
3. Take the **145/8/OH-57 (North)** exit - go **0.3** mi
4. Continue towards **LORAIN** - go **0.5** mi
5. Continue on **LORAIN BLVD (OH-57 is Lorain Blvd in this area)** - go **0.8** mi
6. Stay in the left lane, at the 2<sup>nd</sup> light turn **L** onto **I-90 WEST**
7. Take **I-90 WEST/OH-2/OHIO TURNPIKE** towards **TOLEDO** - go **1.4** mi
8. Continue on **OH-2 WEST** - go **1.3** mi
9. Take the **MIDDLE RIDGE RD/BROADWAY AVE** exit - go **0.2** mi
10. Turn **R** on **MIDDLE RIDGE RD (Broadway Street)**- go **0.2** mi
11. Continue on **MIDDLE RIDGE RD (Broadway Street)** to the intersection of **COOPER FOSTER PARK RD W**
12. Turn **L** (West) on **COOPER FOSTER PARK RD W** - go **1.2** mi
13. Turn **R** on **OBERLIN AVE** - go **0.8** mi
14. Proceed approximately 1 mile. **Rosewood Place** is on the right. Arrive at **4493 OBERLIN AVE, LORAIN**

The purpose of this convention is to carry the message of recovery to women who wish to share in a broader experience of recover. Some of you may wonder why you have to pay since there are no dues or fees for A.A. membership. This is a special event, not an A.A. meeting. We have months of planning preparation and money to present. Since this event is held at a commercial business there is a charge for the group to use the facility. Along with the facility, the party center requires the purchase of coffee, other beverages, cream, sugar & the meal from them. These are basic and necessary expenses. Other expenses include those for printing of flyers, postage & supplies.

FAQ. Is this affiliated with AA World Services?

A. No. This is not affiliated with AA World Services. The convention format is based upon the 12 Steps and 12 Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous and is hosted by a committee of sober women desiring to share a spiritual day with other sober women.

FAQ. Who Should Attend?

A. Any woman wishing to channel her recovery in a positive way. Meet new and old friends sharing the common bond of alcoholism and womanhood.

FAQ. Why do I have to pay?

A. No AA funds are used to pay for this convention. There are many expenses involved that go beyond the normal meeting. There are mailings, flyers, food, and hall rental to name a few. The cost of these expenses is absorbed by the price of the ticket.
